## **Information on the processing of your personal data**

---

We hereby inform you about the processing of your personal data by the GSK and about your rights under data protection law.

### **Who is responsible for data processing and who is the data protection officer?**

### **Which of your personal data do we have and where does this come from?**

The following data in particular belong to the processed categories of personal data:

- Your master data (first name, last name, name extensions, functions)
- Perhaps photo and video material

Your personal data is generally collected directly from you during the registration process or it was provided to us by your office. Photos and videos will also be taken during the events of the association.

### **For what purposes and on what legal basis is data processed?**

We process your personal data in compliance with the provisions of the EU Data Protection Ordinance (DS-GVO), the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) and all other relevant laws. First and foremost, data processing is used for event organization of GSK. The photographs

and videos taken at the event may be published on the Internet or in one of our publications for public relations purposes of the association.

The primary legal basis for this is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. f DS-GVO. Should we wish to process your personal data for a purpose not mentioned above, we will inform you in advance.

### **How long will your data be stored?**

We delete your personal data as soon as they are no longer required for the above-mentioned purposes or if you make use of your right of objection. We ensure the deletion by means of a deletion concept with regular checks of the data.

### **Who gets your data?**

Within our association, persons and departments (e.g. departments) receive your personal data which they need to fulfil our statutory tasks. In addition, we make use of various service providers to fulfil our statutory tasks. Since the processing of your personal data is primarily for the purpose of sending information and invitations, we commission service providers from the fields of event management and IT with the processing of data in accordance with instructions.

### **What rights can you assert as a data subject?**

They have the rights under Articles 15 - 22 DS-GVO:

- Right of access (Art. 15 DS-GVO)
- Right to correction (Article 16 DS-GVO)
- Right to cancellation (Art. 17 DS-GVO)
- Right to limitation of processing (Art. 18 DS-GVO)
- Right of objection to processing (Art. 21 DS-GVO)
- Right to data transferability (Art. 20 DS-GVO)

### **Right of objection**

We process your data to protect legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit f. DS-GVO, you can object to this processing for reasons arising from your particular situation. We will then no longer process your personal data unless we can prove compelling

reasons worthy of protection for the processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.

### **Are you obliged to provide your data?**

The provision of your personal data is neither required by law nor by contract. You are not obliged to provide us with your personal data. If the data required for registration are not provided, participation in the event is not possible.

### **To what extent do automated individual decisions or profiling measures take place?**

We do not use purely automated processing processes to bring about a decision.
